Ross Photography Contest has a new date! **Pictures will be due into the county office by March 13<sup>th</sup>** and will be judged by a local professional. There are four categories anyone can enter, but only Juniors and Seniors will be eligible for the state contest. First place in each of the categories will be sent on to the state contest.

The four categories are black and white living, black and white nonliving, color living, and color non-living. The guidelines state that the photos MUST have been taken in Arkansas. Refund


Please keep in mind the State Refund Policy. This extends to any and all events where there is a cost associated. The County Office will bill you if any cost incurs from an unannounced absence. If you get sick or there's an emergency in the family, let us know!

#### Please make sure you can attend an event before registering!

75% Refund – 15 working days or more before the event 50% Refund – 11-14 working days before the day of the event No Refund – 10 working days or less before the day of the event No Refund for High Adventure (Backpacking or Horsepacking)

If you receive a scholarship and do not attend event without notice or get sent home from event, you will be responsible for the entire registration amount and forgo the scholarship.

You must contact the county office if you are not able to make your event.
