SALINE COUNTY QUORUM COURT MINUTES JUNE 21, 2021

The Saline County Quorum Court met on Monday, June 21, 2021 at 6:30 p.m. in Courtroom #3 in the Saline County Courthouse. County Judge Jeff Arey called the meeting to order. Justice of the Peace Jim Whitley gave the invocation and Judge Arey led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll call was taken with twelve members present, Tammy Schmidt was absent.

Saline County Collector Holly Sanders, Collector Chief Deputy Jennifer Carter, Circuit Clerk Chief Deputy Ragan Kyzer, Sheriff Rodney Wright, Comptroller Angie Drummond, County Attorney Will Gruber, County Judge Administrative Assistant Vicki Hopkins, County Clerk Doug Curtis, County Clerk Office Manager Allison Cain, County Clerk Voter Registrar Lydia Brown, and County Clerk Chief Deputy Lisa Montgomery were present.

Motion made by J.R. Walters and seconded by Ed Albares to approve the minutes from the regular May 17, 2021 and the Special May 24, 2021 meetings. Motion passed unanimously by voice vote.
