PROCLAMATION 2022 LADY PANTHERS SOFTBALL TEAM

WHEREAS: the 5A Central 2022 Benton Lady Panthers Softball Team made history this year, being undefeated (63 – 0) for the last two years, 31-0 in 2021 and 32-0 in 2022; and,

WHEREAS: they finished with a record of 31-0 in 2021 and finished with a record of 32-0 in 2022; and

WHEREAS: they were named the 5A Central Conference Champs (2021 and 2022) and State Champs (2021 and 2022) and have been named the 5A State Champions for 2022; and

WHEREAS: they beat Green County Tech 3 – 2 in the State championship game, beat 6A Bentonville, Rogers, Bryant and Cabot, scoring 25 runs to their 8; and,

WHEREAS, the County has been awarded a Court Security Grant for the 2022 year for the upgrades and additions of security equipment in the amount of \$20,000 (Article 1); and

WHEREAS, the Finance Committee previously met and approve this request.
