SALINE COUNTY QUORUM COURT MINUTES JULY 19, 2021

The Saline County Quorum Court met on Monday, July 19, 2021 at 6:30 p.m. in Courtroom #3 in the Saline County Courthouse. County Judge Jeff Arey called the meeting to order. Justice of the Peace Jim Whitley gave the invocation and Judge Arey led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll call was taken with eleven members present. Carlton Billingsley and David Gibson were absent.

County Clerk Chief Deputy Lisa Montgomery announced that this would be her final Quorum Court meeting to attend and introduced Lydia Brown, who will be taking her place at the Quorum Court meetings taking minutes and calling the roll upon Ms. Montgomery's retirement effective July 24, 2021.

Saline County Circuit Clerk Myka Sample, Circuit Clerk Chief Deputy Ragan Kyzer, County Judge Administrative Assistant Vicki Hopkins, County Attorney Will Gruber, Comptroller Angie Drummond, County Sheriff Chief Deputy Dustin Robertson, Election Commissioner Jamie Clemmer, County Clerk Doug Curtis, County Clerk Voter Registrar Lydia Brown, and County Clerk Chief Deputy Lisa Montgomery were present.

Motion was made by J.R. Walters and seconded by Tammy Schmidt to approve the minutes from the June 21, 2021 quorum court meeting. Motion passed unanimously by voice vote.

WHEREAS, the Public Defender's office had a part-time employee who met the hourly and 90-day threshold that required wages to be subject to both retirement benefits and withholding through Arkansas Public Employees Retirement System (APERS) due to the number of hours worked in a consecutive 90-day time period by such employee. The Public Defender requests to transfer \$1,025.64 from the Public Defender Fund, Small Equipment line item to the Retirement line item (Article 1); and,

WHEREAS. the Sheriff requests funds of \$536.46 be appropriated to the salary line item for additional pay for the Sheriff's Administrative Assistant for bilingual language skills and duties (Article 2); and,

WHEREAS, the Finance Committee previously met and approved this request.
