The Avilla Community will be hosting a Mobile Office for Saline County Judge Jeff Arey on Tuesday, May 3<sup>rd</sup>. The concept of a mobile office began last year with Judge Arey's desire to make himself easily accessible to the public. According to Judge Arey "The idea of a mobile office has worked very well. By going to different areas around the county I get to meet with people in their communities. I believe it conveys the fact that I care about the issues that concern them and it helps me do my job better. My goal for the next couple of years is to go to every area in Saline County, especially those that are more remote. I want the residents of each community to know that I have not forgotten them – they matter to this office."

In April Judge Arey and his staff held a Mobile Office in the Shaw Community. While there Judge Arey met with area residents and listened to their concerns and questions about roads, the new Everbridge Storm Warning system, and answered other questions related to county business. Staff members Katie Davis, the Veterans Service Officer, and Jeff Stroud, Assistant Road Superintendent, were also there.
