



Given the recent storms, the Street Department has generously offered to expand their annual Spring Cleanup to include a special Storm Cleanup event.

The same rules apply on this one as all the others. If you need a refresher, here you go.

- No garbage. Limbs, branches, leaves, and other yard debris are all that will be picked up.
- No bags. Anything left in a bag will not be picked up.
- Nothing in the street. Everything must be behind the curb (if you have one) or clearly away from the street if you don't.
- Limbs up to 3" in diameter will be picked up. No logs or stumps.

If you're interested, here are the three steps you need to follow to get your stuff picked up. Make sure to take note of the new dates.

1. During the week of May 8-12, call the Street Department at (501) 776-5990 and tell them you want to get on the Storm Cleanup list.
2. Clean up your yard and pile all of the debris next to (not on) the street.
3. Wait patiently for the Street Department to come pick it up.

Pickup will begin on the 15th of May and continue until they're done. I expect the list will be very long for this service, so please be patient – they'll get there as soon as they can.
