Many thanks to you and the Saline County Quorum Court for awarding a \$15,000 grant to the HSV Animal Welfare League for its animal control programs. We continue to spay and neuter the cats and dogs of Saline County residents as well as providing rabies and other vaccinations, adoptions of stray and surrendered animals, and providing vet care for owned pets with medical emergencies.
